**QUALIFIED DIVIDENDS**

None of the ordinary dividends shown in Box 1a are considered qualified dividends.

**"DIVIDENDS RECEIVED DEDUCTION" FOR CORPORATIONS**

None of the ordinary dividends reported in Box 1a on Form 1099-DIV qualifies for the **Corporate "dividends received deduction."** There is no "dividends received deduction" for individuals.

**TAX TREATMENT OF FOREIGN TAXES PAID**

The Fund did not qualify to pass through any foreign tax credits to shareholders.

**NON-DIVIDEND DISTRIBUTIONS PAID**

28.98% of the total distribution paid out by the Fund was a non-dividend distribution ("return of capital") and is reported in Box 3 on Form 1099-DIV. Return of capital distributions represent a return of your cost basis and your cost basis should be reduced by the reported amount.
