Allocation Effect:

Allocation effect is the portion of portfolio excess return attributed to taking different group bets from the benchmark. (If either the portfolio or the benchmark has no position in a given group, allocation effect is the lone effect.) A group's allocation effect equals the weight of the portfolio's group minus the weight of the benchmark's group times the total return of the benchmark group minus the total return of the benchmark in aggregate.

Selection Effect:

Selection effect is the portion of portfolio excess return attributable to choosing different securities within groups from the benchmark. A group's selection effect equals the weight of the benchmark's group multiplied by the total return of the portfolio's group minus the total return of the benchmark's group.

Interaction Effect:

Interaction effect is the portion of the portfolio's excess return attributable to combining allocation decisions with relative performance. This effect measures the strength of the manager's convictions. The interaction effect is the weight differential times the return differential. A group's interaction effect equals the weight of the portfolio's group minus the weight of the benchmark's group times the total return of the portfolio's group minus the total return of the benchmark's group.

Total Effect:

The total effect is the sum of all three effects. The total effect represents the opportunity cost of your investment decisions in a group relative to the overall benchmark.

VanEck Global Hard Assets Fund's annualized returns for the Institutional Shares (Class I) as of December 31, 2019: 1-year, 12.06%; 5-year, -5.45%; Since inception, -0.58%.

Expenses are calculated for the 12-month period ending 12/31/19: Class A: Gross 1.59% and Net 1.38%; Class C: Gross 2.32% and Net 2.20%; Class I: Gross 1.06% and Net 0.95%; and Class Y: Gross 1.20% and Net 1.13%. Expenses are capped contractually through 05/01/21 at 1.38% for Class A; 2.20% for Class C; 0.95% for Class I; and 1.13% for Class Y.
