Summary: The Analyst on the ETF Capital Markets team will be an ETF trading subject matter expert by understanding ETF trading from the point of view of a market maker/trading desk. This person will work to educate the trading community on VanEck Vectors ETFs' product structures, creation/redemption processes, and ways to price and trade ETFs. In addition, this role will also be responsible for being the firm's "liquidity expert" for all sales channels.

This is a full-time position located in Midtown Manhattan. The individual in this position will be required to work in office 4 days a week, but the office is open five days a week for those who wish to come in daily.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

Includes the following, other duties may be assigned as needed:

- Monitor daily secondary market trading in VanEck Vectors ETFs and work with portfolio managers, APs and market makers to support seamless ETF creation/redemption processes.
- Collaborate with product development, portfolio management and institutional sales to ensure the ETF trading community perspective is represented in product management decisions.
- Identify and lead the development/implementation around any improvements to VanEck's internal ETF platform.
- Author periodic reports and whitepapers around ETF Capital Markets thought leadership. Topics may include product liquidity, trading practices, etc.
- Develop and manage new or existing relationships with external firms including exchanges, market makers, institutional trading desks, proprietary traders, and data vendors.
- Support ETF Sales and international teams as the firm's "ETF Trading Expert" in order to better position VanEck Vectors ETFs to clients.
- Educate clients on trading best practices including how to achieve best execution for VanEck Vectors ETFs.
- Collaborate with ETF Capital Markets counterparts globally.
