Summary: The Product Analyst works collaboratively with other members of the ETF Product Management team to help develop, market and support specifically VanEck's municipal bond ETF suite as well as the potential to assist in the support of VanEck's separately managed accounts and ETF model portfolios. This person must have passion for investments, an aptitude for utilizing systems to analyze data, and a demonstrated ability to communicate complex concepts simply. This role requires attention to detail, great communication skills, the ability to manage many competing tasks and strong interpersonal skills.

- Assists in the development, production, and updating of marketing materials (e.g. presentations, sales ideas, emails, press releases, etc.)
- Research competitors and analyze comparative performance, characteristics, and market trends to aid product development or marketing initiatives

- Participate in product development initiatives with expeditious analysis of new fund ideas as assigned
- Respond to product inquiries from Sales, including supporting RFP and DDQ requests with data as requested
- Other duties or special projects may be assigned as needed
